REPORT ON PARTICIPATION IN THE FIRST CALL OF THE UNA4CAREER POSTDOCTORAL FELLOWSHIPS PROGRAMME




In this report, a detailed analysis of the participation data in the First Call of the UNA4CAREER postdoctoral fellowships programme is presented. The purpose of this call, on a competitive basis, is the incorporation of postdoctoral researchers into the research groups of the Universidad Complutense de Madrid (UCM) classified as "excellent", for the development of 36-month research projects in any area of knowledge.

Aspects such as the number of applications received, their distribution among the 4 knowledge areas envisaged -Humanities, Social Sciences, Health and Experimental Sciences-, nationality, gender, age and reasons for exclusion of the non-eligible proposals, are analysed.


Total number of proposals submitted.

The total number of proposals submitted is 135. Of these, 107 (79%) meet the eligibility criteria and go on to the evaluation procedure, and 28 (21%) do not meet the eligibility criteria of the call.




Eligible Proposals by Panel.

The total amount of proposals submitted, are organized into four scientific panels: Humanities, Social Sciences, Health and Experimental Sciences. 15 proposals (14%) have been received by the Humanities panel, 16 proposals (15%) have been received by the Social Sciences panel, 12 proposals (11%) have been received by the Health panel and 64 proposals (60%) have been received by the Experimental Sciences panel.



The number of proposals received in each panel is in line with the number of research groups per panel at the UCM that have been classified as "excellent" in the external evaluation done by the Spanish National Research Agency. At the UCM, "excellent" research groups in Humanities account for 17% of the total number of "excellent" groups, research groups in Social Sciences 10%, research groups in Health 18% and research groups in Experimental Sciences 55% of the total number of groups classified as "excellent".




Nationality of applicants among submitted proposals.

People from 36 different nationalities have applied to the UNA4CAREER programme. The highest figure corresponds to Spanish nationality, which is because Spanish applicants find in these fellowships a good opportunity to come back to Spain after a postdoctoral phase abroad. India, Argentina and Italy are the following three countries with the largest number of candidates.


Gender of applicants among submitted proposals.

Of the 135 proposals submitted, 82 were from men and 53 from women. A ratio of 60% - 40% between men and women is established.




Age of applicants among submitted proposals.

The age range of the proposals received is between 27 and 62 years old, with the most common range being between 31 and 37 years.



Causes of exclusion.

The main reasons for exclusion were related to the technical proposal (code 0426) and the documentation presented in relation to the mobility criterion (code 0424). The third reason has been not signing the document of data veracity (code 0429).



0426	The Technical Proposal (Annex II) is not submitted using the official template provided / Page limits according to the template are not respected / Editing standards according to the template are not respected. Points 5.1 and 4.4.a.4 of the call.
0424	Documentation proving compliance with the mobility requirement has not been provided/ Is insufficient to demonstrate consistency with Annex III / This documentation is not translated into English. Points 5.1, 4.4.a.2, 4.4.a.5, 4.4.b and 3.1.1 of the call.
0429	Annex V has not been provided / Is not signed by the applicant. Points 5.1 and 4.4.a.8 of the call.
0427	Annex III has not been provided / Does not contain suitable information about the applicant's geographic mobility in the three years prior to the deadline for submitting applications. Points 5.1 and 4.4.a.5 of the call.
0425	Annex I has not been provided / Is not signed by the director of the research group to which the applicant's tutor researcher belongs and/or by the director of the department to which the applicant will be assigned. Points 5.1 and 4.4.a.6 of the call.
0430	The applicant's tutor researcher does not belong to an #excellent# research group. Points 5.1 and 3.2 of the call.
0235	The documentation provided does not prove that the applicant is a doctor on the closing date of the call / This documentation is not translated into English. Points 5.1, 4.4.b and 3.1.2 of the call.
